Dear parents,

I recommend that your child reviews the following books and pages to get ready for the assessments:

MATHS:

<u>Arithmetic Monday 16th March 08:40</u>: your child will be asked to solve different equations, such as additions, subtractions, multiplications and divisions.

For this they will need to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 times tables.

Reasoning Tuesday 17th March 08:40: your child will be asked to solve problems money, change and graph interpretations. We have been working on these concepts through the whole term. They will be tested on understanding the Mathematical vocabulary as well as being able to continue number lines and know the value of each digit in a 3-digit number (hundreds, tens and units). These are included in their Collins Busy Ants Maths Pupil book B units 5 (w1 and 2) 6 (weeks 1 and 3), 7 (week 3) and 8 (week 3).

LITERACY:

<u>Reading comprehension</u> Monday 16th March 10:50: your child will be given a short story that includes vocabulary that they should know. They will be given some questions about the text to answer. We have been practicing this kind of activity in school. If you would wish to practice at home, I recommend that they read a story and you give them easy specific questions about the story (who is....?, what did...do?, why....?).

<u>SPAG</u> Monday 23rd March 08:40: your child will be tested on their SPAG skills. The questions will come from their Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation skills book GRAMMAR: units 5-12, sentence structure and to be able to order words in alphabetical order. From their SPELLING book units 9-17.

<u>SPELLING TEST</u> Tuesday 17th March 11:40: they will have a spelling test including 25 of the 50 words that they have been given to practice at home. The words will be from the weekly spelling test that they have had during the whole term.
